Objectives of networking

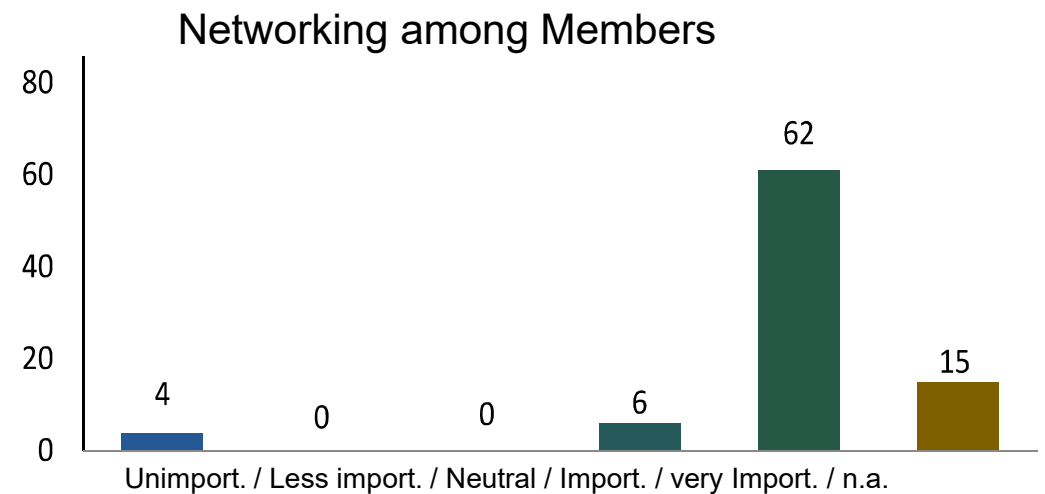
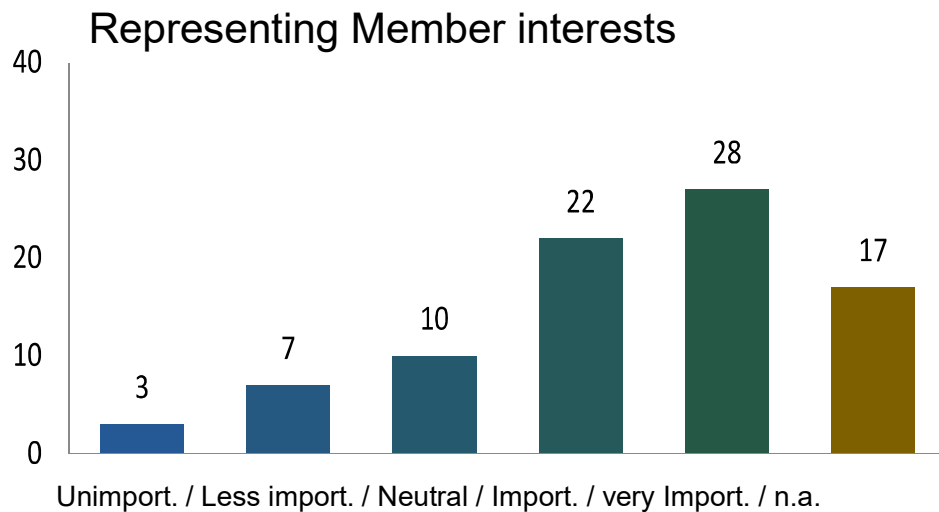
- Networking has to be done in 2 direction:
 - ↗ Networking within the cluster
 - ↗ Networking with actors outside the cluster

Networking within the cluster

Type of cluster

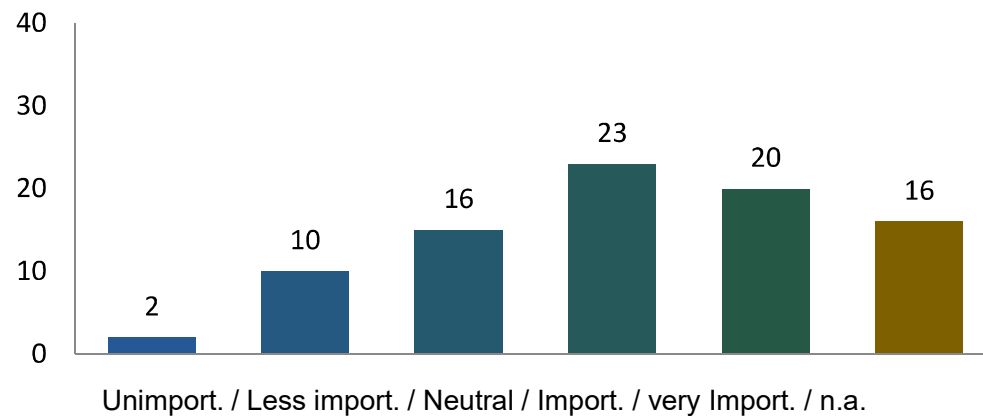
- Networking demands clearly depend on the type of cluster
 - ↪ who belongs to the cluster and
 - ↪ what relations exist among the cluster members
 - ↪ regional composition in the cluster (national/international)
- How did the cluster get started. Is trust existing already or has it to be established by
 - ↪ Trust building measures (f.i. definition of rules etc.)
 - ↪ Are the cluster's objectives clearly defined
 - ↪ Are there heterogeneous interests among the members

Network aspects perceived by cluster managements (1/3)

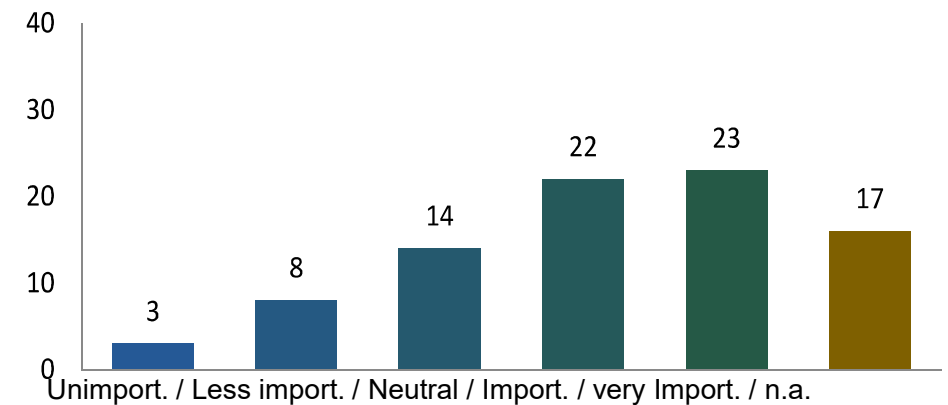


Network aspects perceived by cluster managements (2/3)

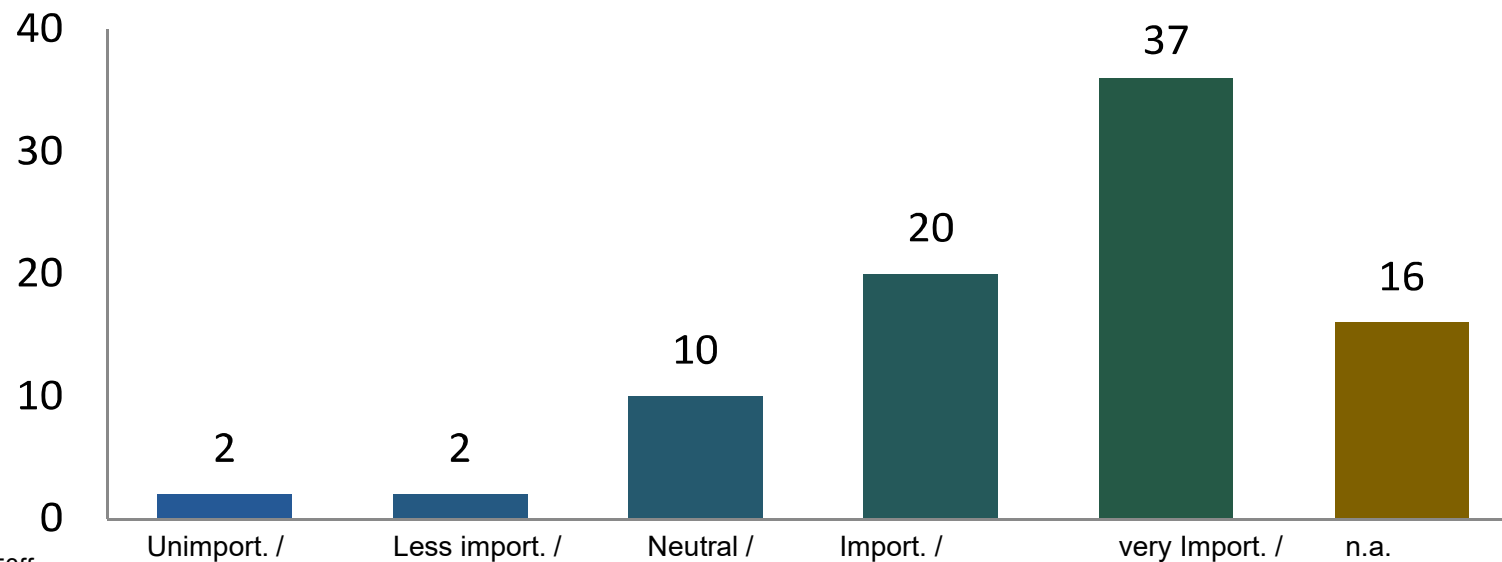

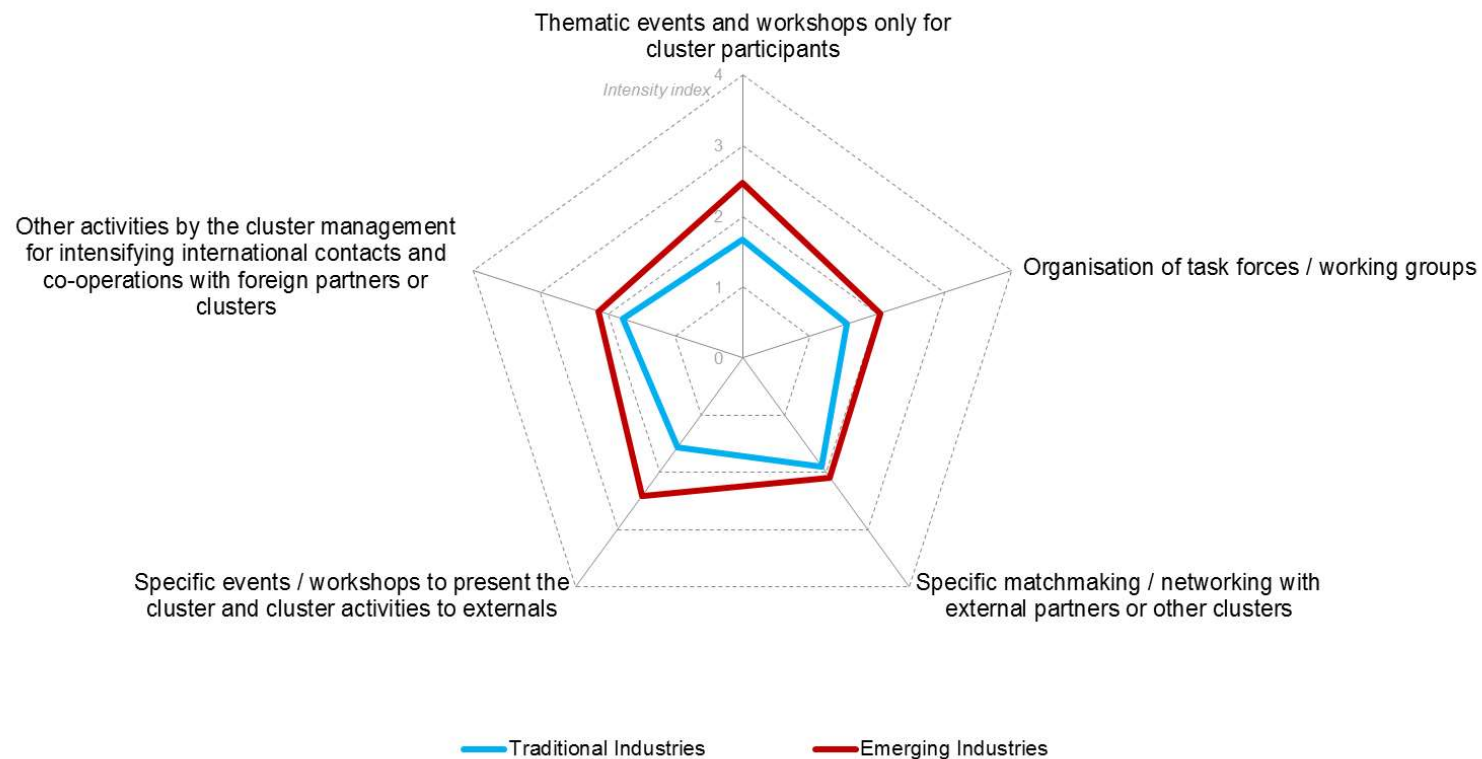
Network aspects perceived by cluster managements (3/3)

Requirements for networking in clusters

- Appropriate internal data structure
- Developing network dialogue formats
- Commitment creating

Data structure

- A major impediment is accessibility to cluster information
- We used in our clusters cloud solutions as „coyo“, „Nevaal“ or sharepoint
- A clearly defined structure with carefully set rights are required
- Routines for paper writings is necessary

Dialogue formats

- How many sessions
- with how many participants
- in what sequence are required

- Digital, Hybrid, or in person meetings are adequate
- How to get people to work – clear delivery tasks to be defined

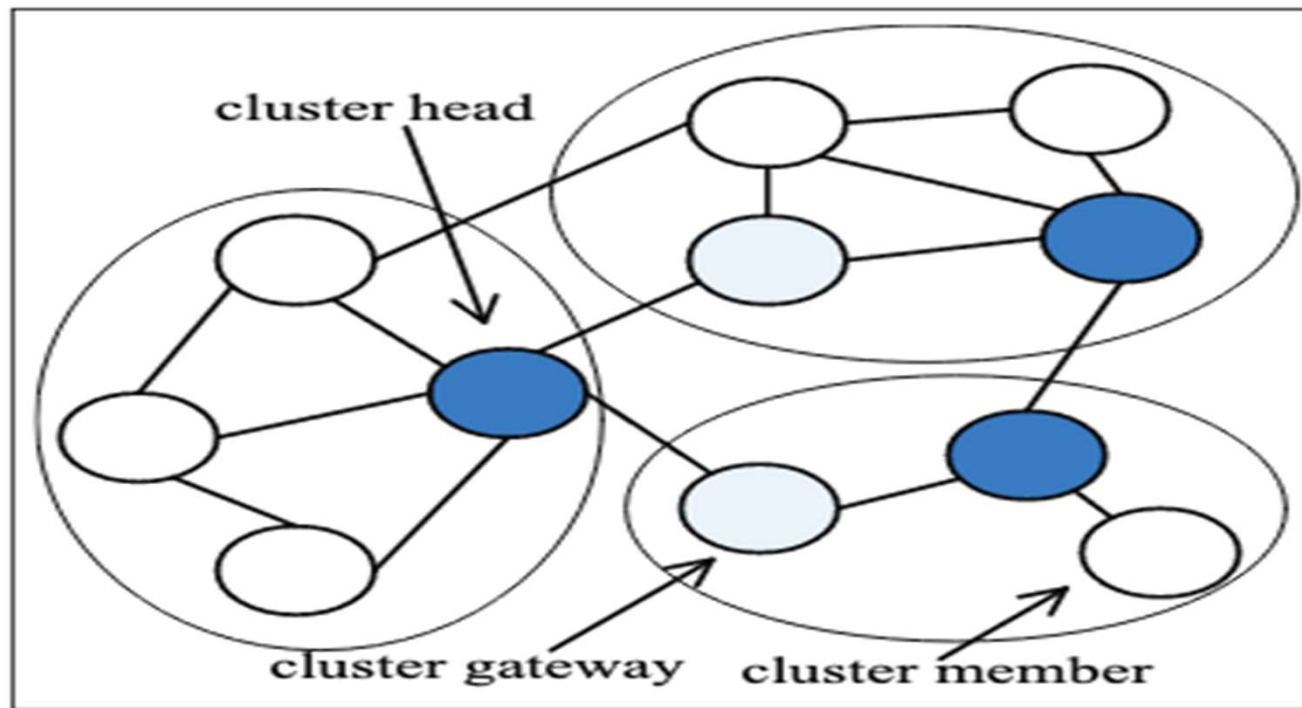
Committment creation

- Setting joint objectives and foow up if they are not reached
- Identifying clear impediments and settle measure to overcome those
- Getting different actors into a collaboration mode (DIY vs profesional actors)

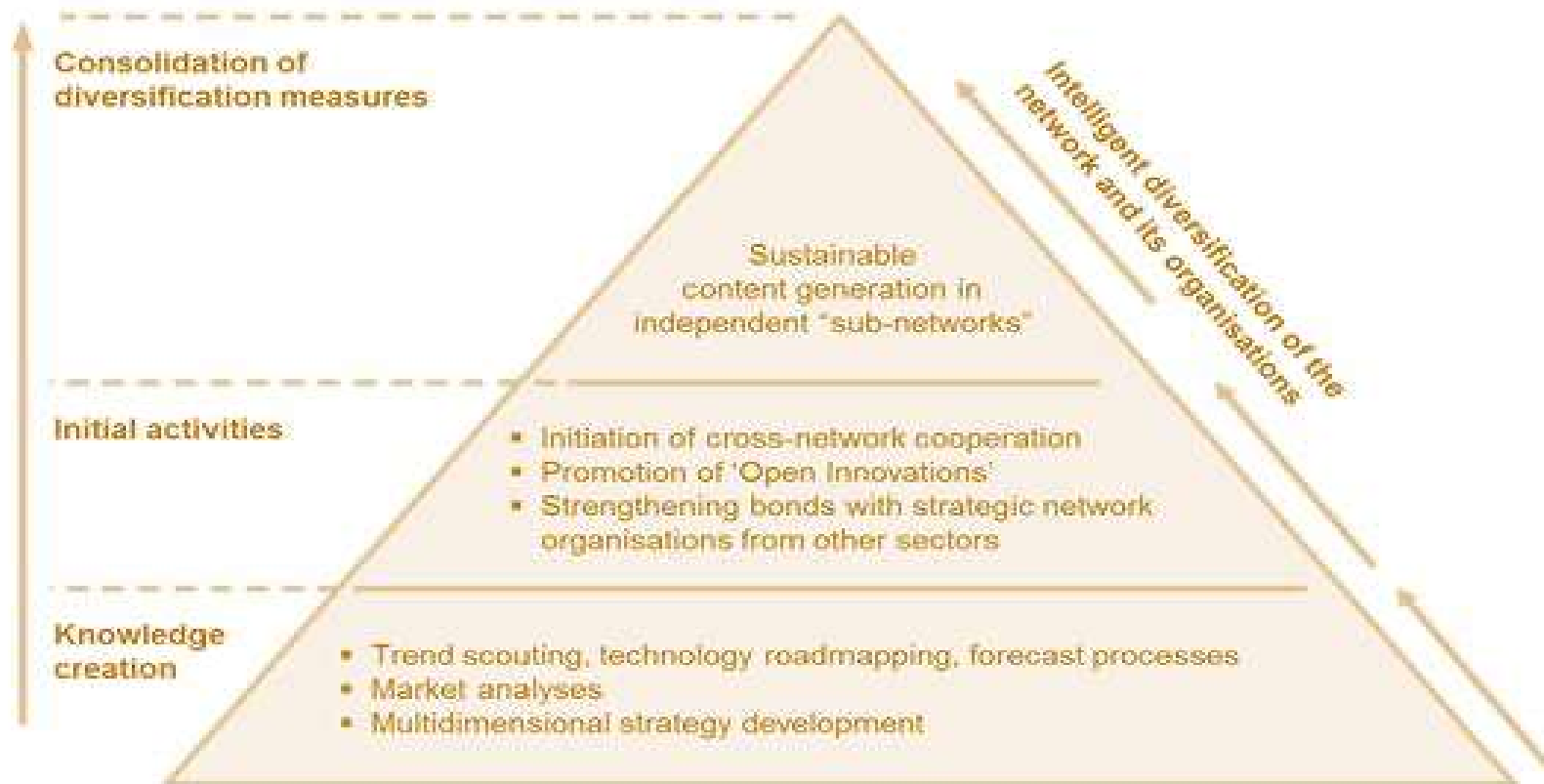

Whom do cluster collaborate with? (CRIE, 22.2.2021)

- In national collaborations known partners are preferred
- In international collaborations prior collaboration experience with the partner is less relevant
- A middle match of cultural and cognitive similarity is preferred by SME
- Large enterprises are mainly driven by thematic considerations

Modes of Cluster Collaboration (Interspin, 2019)

- International cluster cooperation by meetings (fairs, individual meetings, etc.)
- Joint events and newsletter are used in national & international collaborations
- R&D projects are frequently used as a mean for collaboration
